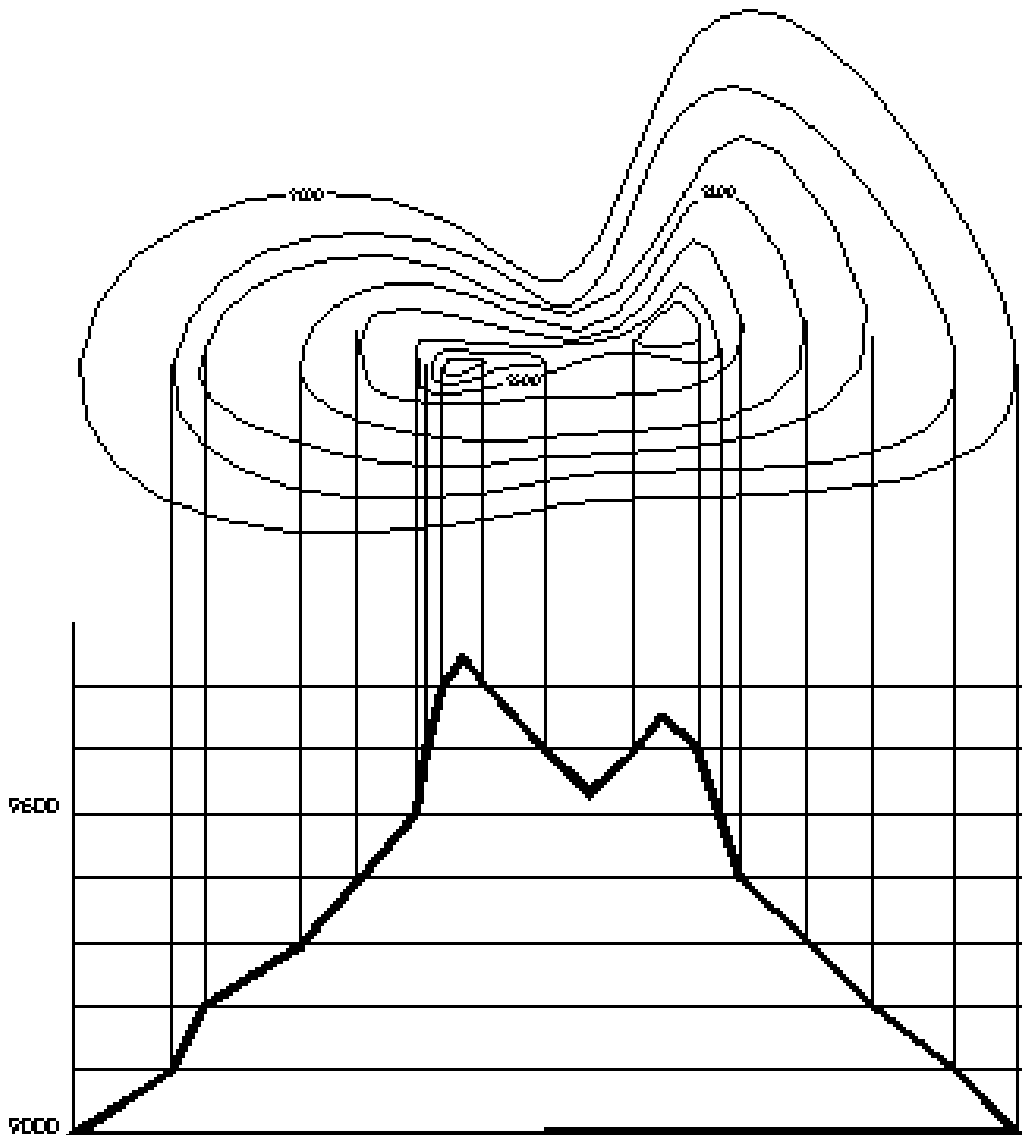


CONTOUR LINES

HOW TO GET THE PICTURE



CONTOUR LINES are lines drawn on a map connecting points of equal elevation. If you walk along a contour line you neither gain or lose elevation.

Contour lines are normally drawn in brown on Ordnance Survey Maps, with a darker line every 50 metres.

CONTOUR LINES

Work this one out!

Metres above mean Sea Level - Contours are at 10metres Vertical
